# SPRINGTIME AT NATURAL LAMB

**W**ieser Concrete produces two primary precast manure storage system options; Pan-L-Bilt Underbarn Manure Storage Systems and L-Panel Manure

Storage Systems. The bulk of these systems are designed for cattle and hogs.

The Pan-L-Bilt system stores manure in a sealed area under the barn with the livestock housed on slatted floor in the building above. Depending on the size of the storage area, the manure is then pumped once or twice a year and spread on the land as fertilizer.

The L-Panel storage system stores manure in an above ground area similar to a lagoon but in a sealed precast structure. Like the Pan-L-Bilt system, the manure stored in the L-Panel system is pumped and spread when the system reaches its storage capacity.

Recently, **Wieser Concrete** delivered slatted floor panels and support posts for **Natural Lamb Finishing LLP** of Iowa. Natural Lamb Finishing produces lamb products for market and asked **Wieser Concrete** to produce precast components for their design.

Once the design was completed, **Wieser Concrete** produced the custom sized slats and posts to accommodate the sheep.

The system designed by Natural Lamb Finishing features a slatted floor pit top which allows the manure to drop through to the void underneath the flooring. The manure is cleaned away using a skid steer which can easily access the storage area through the open ends below the pit top.
