IN CASE OF FIRE

A fire presents many challenges whenever they occur, but when the fire occurs in a place that does not have access to a municipal water supply or a large body of water such as a pond, lake, etc., it can be devastating.

Some communities have updated their zoning regulations to include a requirement for public and commercial buildings that are not connected to large water sources to have adequate onsite water storage for fire protection. The amount of water required to be in storage depends on the size and scope of the facilities. The most cost-effective and secure way to store this amount of water is in underground precast storage tanks produced by **Wieser Concrete**.

Fire protection water storage was one of the upgrades made when the **Prairie Creek Community School** of Northfield, Minnesota began their school expansion. Prairie Creek Community School is a

public charter school for kindergarten through fifth grade. The school is located in a rural setting outside of Northfield, Minnesota. Due to its educational success, Prairie Creek Community School found they needed to renovate their current facilities and add additional space to accommodate their growing student population.

To accommodate the fire prevention water storage requirements for the Prairie Creek Community School, **Metro Fire Protection of Owatonna, Minnesota**, installed a 30,000 gallon **Wieser Concrete** precast tank. This single-compartment tank manufactured to meet the project specifications was ordered in January and delivered to the jobsite in March.
