This project is the sixth veterans cemetery expansion using **Wieser Concrete's** precast burial vaults

and the second expansion for the Abraham Lincoln National Cemetery. The first expansion at Abraham Lincoln National Cemetery was completed in 2005.

The vaults on these projects are placed on a prepared gravel base, leveled, backfilled and then covered with the top of the vaults being at ground level when project is completed. This process allows for maximum efficiency both in installation and costs.
