DOWN THE DRAIN

Have you ever wondered what happens to all the water when the rain starts falling on large areas of asphalt and concrete? We know it goes “down the drain” but what happens then?

For many years, stormwater went into the main storm sewers and directly to the closest waterway but often there would be more water than the systems could manage. This resulted in untreated storm water entering the natural waterways.
